TO ASK POTENTIAL MAKE UP ARTISTS

Finding the right makeup artist for your wedding day is essential to achieving the look you envision and feeling your best.

1. EXPERIENCE AND EXPERTISE

How long have you been doing bridal makeup?	
Do you specialize in any particular makeup styles (natural, glam, etc.)?	
Can you provide a portfolio or examples of your previous bridal work?	
Have you worked with clients who have similar skin tones and types as mine?	
Do you have experience with different cultural or traditional bridal looks?	

2. AVAILABILITY AND BOOKING

Are you available on my wedding date?	
How far in advance should I book your services?	
Do you offer a makeup trial session, and what is the cost?	
How long does a trial session last, and how many looks can we try?	
Will you personally be doing my makeup on the wedding day, or will someone else from your team?	

3. PRICING AND PAYMENT

What are your rates for wedding day makeup services?	
Do you charge a flat fee or by the hour?	
Are there any additional costs for travel, parking, or early start times?	
What is your deposit requirement, and when is the final payment due?	
Do you offer packages for bridal parties, and what do they include?	

4. WEDDING DAY LOGISTICS

How long will it take to complete my makeup on the wedding day?	
How do you schedule the makeup application if multiple people need services?	
Will you come to my location, or do I need to come to your studio?	
What will you do if there are any last-minute changes to the schedule or my desired look?	
Can you accommodate touch-ups throughout the day, and is there an additional fee for this service?	

5. PRODUCTS AND TECHNIQUES

What brands of makeup do you use, and are they suitable for my skin type?

Do you offer airbrush makeup, and what are the pros and cons compared to traditional makeup?

Can you work with specific requests, such as using cruelty-free, vegan, or hypoallergenic products?

How do you ensure the longevity of the makeup throughout the wedding day?

Do you provide any aftercare tips or products for touch-ups during the day?

6. HEALTH AND HYGIENE

How do you ensure the cleanliness and sanitation of your tools and products?

What precautions do you take for clients with sensitive skin or allergies?

7. COMMUNICATION AND POLICIES

How do you prefer to communicate leading up to the wedding (email, phone, in-person)?

What is your policy on cancellations or changes to the booking?

Can you provide references or testimonials from past brides?

How do you handle feedback if I'm not completely satisfied after the trial?

Asking these questions will help you gauge the makeup artist's professionalism, expertise, and suitability for your needs, ensuring a flawless and stress-free experience on your big day.
