MATERIALS & PRINTING	
What paper types, weights, and finishes do you offer (e.g., handmade, textured, recycled)?	
Do you provide specialty printing like foil stamping, letterpress, embossing, or die-cuts?	
Do you offer embellishments (vellum wraps, wax seals, ribbons, envelope liners, pockets)?	
Can I see and feel samples of paper and finishes?	
PACKAGES & PRODUCTS	
Do you offer full suites (save-the-dates, invitations, RSVP cards, details cards, menus, programs, signage, thank-you notes)?	
Can you design matching day-of items (seating charts, place cards, signage, menus, favor tags)?	
Do you provide digital options, such as PDFs for email or wedding websites?	

What is your pricing structure — flat rate, per piece, or package?	
What is the minimum order quantity?	
What is included in the price (design, printing, assembly, envelopes, addressing)?	
Are there additional costs for upgrades like foil, letterpress, or custom artwork?	
LOGISTICS & POLICIES	
Do you handle addressing and mailing, or is that up to us?	
What are your payment terms and deposit requirements?	
What is your policy for changes after design approval?	
Do you provide a written contract with all services and costs?	
EXTRA & FINAL TOUCHES	
Do you offer envelope calligraphy or digital printing for guest addresses?	
Can you coordinate colors with my wedding palette, florals, or attire?	
Do you provide etiquette guidance on invitation wording and addressing?	
Do you offer keepsakes, like a framed invitation suite?	

Pro Tip: Couples should bring their wedding date, guest count estimate, budget range, and any inspiration images when meeting a stationer — it makes the conversation smoother and more

productive.
