SIGN & CUSTOMIZATION

Can you work with inspiration photos or mood boards?	
Do you offer mockups of centerpieces/bouquets before the wedding?	
How do you ensure our flowers match our color palette and theme?	
Can you incorporate non-floral elements (candles, lanterns, pampas grass, dried florals)?	
SEASONALITY & FLOWER CHOICES	
What flowers will be in season for our date?	
What substitutions do you recommend if certain blooms aren't available?	
Can you source locally grown flowers or sustainable options?	
Do you have suggestions for allergy-friendly flowers?	
ARRANGEMENTS & DECOR	
Do you provide bouquets, boutonnieres, corsages, and flower crowns?	
Can you create ceremony décor (arches, aisle flowers, altar arrangements)?	
Do you handle reception décor (centerpieces, garlands, hanging installations, cake flowers)?	
Do you rent vases, candles, arches, or stands, or do we provide our own?	

How do you structure your pricing — by item, package, or overall budget?	
Can you work within our budget and suggest ways to maximize it?	
What is included in your quote (delivery, setup, breakdown, rentals)?	
Do you have a minimum spend requirement?	
POLICIES & FINE PRINT	
What is your deposit and payment schedule?	
What happens if certain flowers aren't available due to seasonality or supply issues?	
What is your cancellation or refund policy?	
Do you provide a written contract with itemized costs?	
EXTRAS & TIPS	
Do you provide preservation services for bouquets after the wedding?	
Do you repurpose ceremony flowers for the reception?	
Can you coordinate with the baker for cake flowers and the planner for overall design?	
Do you offer advice on floral care and storage before the wedding day?	

Pro Tip for Couples: Bring your color palette, photos of your attire, and an idea of your budget to the florist meeting. This helps the florist give realistic suggestions that align with your style and season.
